

1971 – The cornerstone for Woodlawn's new sanctuary was set in place.

1972 – In January, special services celebrated the dedication of Woodlawn's new church to the glory of the Triune God.

1975 - Woodlawn's unique dove, given as a gift by the Knuth family, designed and built by member Jerry Harders, was set in place over the altar area.

1979 – Woodlawn congregation celebrated 50 years of God's Grace.

1983 – Mr. Jay Schwall accepted the call to replace Robert Kolander as Woodlawn Lutheran School principal. Mr. Kolander continued to serve the congregation as part time teacher, choir director and organist.

1986 – On August 24th Woodlawn's new addition of a gym-fellowship hall, office and library was dedicated.

1988 – A special service was held on February 28th, commemorating Pastor Schulz' 25 years of ministry at Woodlawn congregation, with Pastor Harold Wicke preaching.

1990 – Rev. Thomas Kneser accepted the congregation's Call as Woodlawn's first co-pastor.



1992 – Mr. Robert Kolander retired from his duties at Woodlawn School and as music and choir director, after 45 years of dedicated service.

1994 – A new Rogers's electronic, computerized organ was purchased and dedicated.

1995 – Pastor Schulz enters semi-retirement. He remains a member and preaches occasionally. Vicars are called to Woodlawn to assist.

1999 – Woodlawn celebrates its 70th anniversary.

2000 – The sanctuary was remodeled, adding a granite wall and stained glass windows in the front of the church. Hand bells were purchased to enhance the worship services.

2001 – The schools of Woodlawn and Jordan were merged to form Lamb of God School in our existing building. August 28th welcomed students and parents to the "new" Lamb of God School.

2002 – Pastor Benjamin Wessel was assigned to Woodlawn after his graduation from the seminary. He was ordained and installed at

Woodlawn. His residence is at a home on 90th Street purchased from the Mr. & Mrs. Robert Kolander. Lamb of God School broke ground for a new classroom addition in June.

2003 – In January, the Early Childhood Education Wing opened for classes.

2004 – March, Woodlawn celebrated 75 Years of Growing in Christ! A contemporary choir is formed to assist in worship on a regular basis.

2006 - Pastor Kneser was honored as he celebrated 25 years in the ministry.

2008 – Pastor Wessel marries Lynn Buman. They reside in the parsonage, as Pastor Kneser purchased his own home.
